Pam called the meeting to order 8:10.

May minutes corrected date to 5/4/23, Mike moved and Dave  $2^{nd}$  to accept minutes, motion passed.

## Tom issued permits:

- 2) Journey at 2196 Watkins Rd for recreation event center and sign

Received application for zoning change from agriculture to manufacturing and distribution for Ernst Concrete from Connie Klema for 13 acres on north side of Moots Run and east side of Rt 37. Pam moved and Mike  $2^{nd}$  to set public hearing at Church of Christ 6/29 at 7:00, motion passed 5-0. Jim will make a report for evaluation.

Tom also mentioned EPA meeting 6/8 at the church at 6:00.

Jim mentioned the state is looking for a general permit from EPA allowing package plants up to 25,000 gallons/day for sewer operations that is probably 1 year in the future.

Township is looking for service agreements with Granville and other nearby townships for water. If these agreements are in place we might have more control of our future. Township has been trying for 4-5 months to establish service agreements within 60 days. Need Licking County Commissioners approval then it blocks SW Water and Sewer. Jim will meet with a commissioner and then go uninvited with the plan.

Pam has been in contact with Martin Trucking working on landscaping plan with fences to get it done as soon as possible.

Smart code/smart growth plan needs 3 extra work meetings to get in front of the trustees in August. Pam moved and Dave  $2^{nd}$  to schedule 3 public work sessions 1) 6/13 at 5:00-7:00, 2) 7/6 at 5:00-7:00 and 3) 7/11 at 5:00-7:00, motion passed.
