Randal Almendinger talked about the IGA at 4 corners of 310/37, wanting to do a JEDD with the 4 townships involved and each township gets their fair share of the JEDD money.

Bruce Lane said he was not informed about this and got a call from Troy Hendren from Monroe Township, who was not informed about it. Bruce got a copy of the document from Dan Wetzel of Jersey Township and it puts Jersey Township in charge with SWL getting all of the TIF money. Jersey Township gets half of the JEDD money to cover their cost to get it done and then it is divided between the 4 entities. Bruce said there is an enterprise zone in the plans and he is concerned we are going into more that just a JEDD, and says there is only a place for each township board chairman to sign the contract and it needs to be a board decision. He says it is disturbing that they are trying to enter into this without all of the trustees knowing about it.

Randal Almendinger said he will ask Dan Wetzel and Rob Platt to attend our January 9<sup>th</sup> meeting to explain.

Bruce Lane said he has talked to the Licking County Commissioners and they say the township needs to set up a sewer and water authority.

Bruce Lane made a motion to increase appropriations in the General Bond Note fund by \$68,598.89.

## **EMERGENCY MEETING**

The December 28<sup>th</sup> 2023 emergency meeting of St. Albans Township was called to order by Chairman, Randal Almendinger.

All trustees and fiscal officer were present.

The purpose of this meeting is the fire chief needs to get approval on the purchase of radios to secure pricing before year end.

Mike Theisen said for the past couple of months he has been talking about purchasing radios and going to Kenwood from Motorola because pricing for Kenwood was better.

Motorola ended up coming back with a better deal when they heard about the switch, \$28-30,000.00 cheaper.

Mike stated financing is available, however he doesn't think it makes sense to finance at an interest rate of approx. 6% when we have the money available in the budget.

Mike is asking for approval of \$130,729.00 to enter into contract with Motorola for 22 portable radios and 6 mobiles.

Mike said this is a 20 year asset.

There is no value in what we currently have and they have to have new ones by year 2025. The advantage in buying them now is pricing and length of time to receive them, which will be 6-8 months.

<u>Jean Morrison</u> made a motion to enter into contract with Motorola for \$130,728.87 for new radios, which will be 22 portable and 6 mobile.
